

PAPER COLLARS FOR STRAY CATS

Instructions

- 1. Print this sheet
- 2. Write your telephone number in the space provided and cut out the collar.
- 3. Attach a small piece of tape to one of the short edges so you are ready when the cat is within reach. Don't cover the entire collar with tape the collar needs to tear off easily if it gets caught on something.
- 4. Ensure the fitted collar allows for 2 fingers to be placed between the collar and the cat's neck.
- 5. You may need to make a new collar if the first one comes off. If the cat returns and you haven't received any calls attach a new one.
